Procedural Order No 32
(Post-Hearing procedural calendar)

1. At the end of the November 2021 Hearing, the Tribunal discussed with the Parties the procedural calendar for the next steps in the proceeding. It was agreed that the Parties would provide the Tribunal with their proposed procedural calendar. By communication of 24 November 2021, the Parties jointly proposed the procedural timetable for the post-hearing steps.
2. On 1 December 2021, the Tribunal informed the Parties that it approved the proposed procedural steps and suggested an amendment to the timetable. The Tribunal invited the Parties to confirm their agreement to the proposed amendment.
3. Having received the Parties’ agreement by the Claimant’s email of 13 December 2021, and the Respondents’ email of 14 December 2021, the Tribunal now confirms the following procedural calendar:
 - a. Further to the agreed timetable, the Parties provided to ICSID on 10 December 2021 their corrections to the hearing transcripts;
 - b. On or before Monday, 24 January 2022, the Tribunal will transmit to the Parties any questions it wishes to see addressed in post-hearing briefs;
 - c. On or before Monday, 28 February 2022, the Parties will simultaneously file post-hearing briefs of no more than 50 pages (with 12 point font size, in Times New Roman, double spaced, and with 1 inch margins, not including cover pages, tables of contents or signature pages);
 - d. Unless the Tribunal on or before Monday, 28 March 2022, requires something further from the Parties, the Parties will simultaneously file costs statements on or before 15 April 2022;
 - e. On or before Monday, 2 May 2022, the Parties may if desired simultaneously file a brief comment on the costs statement of the opposing side;

- f. The Parties agree that the evidentiary record is and will remain closed unless the Tribunal orders otherwise on a showing of good cause.
