ORDER

For the reasons explained in the corresponding Memorandum Opinion issued this date, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Republic of India's motion [14] to stay is **GRANTED**. The above-captioned matter will be **STAYED** pending further order of the Court.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Republic of India's motion [15] to dismiss is hereby **DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**. This motion may be renewed after the stay is lifted.

It is further **ORDERED** that on or before April 30, 2022, the parties shall file a joint status report providing an update to the Court on the ongoing set-aside proceedings in the Netherlands. The parties shall file additional status reports every thirty (30) days thereafter until the conclusion of the set-aside proceedings.

It is further **ORDERED** that the parties shall notify the Court within three (3) business days of any ruling in the set-aside proceedings in the Netherlands.

It is **SO ORDERED**.
