The Tribunal has considered the requests made by Messrs Sack Goldblatt Mitchell in their letters of 7 January 2003 and 17 March 2003 concerning their clients' application for *amicus* standing, and the related request made on behalf of UPS on 9 January 2003.

The parties are to make available to Messrs Sack Goldblatt Mitchell copies of their current and any future pleadings. The Tribunal notes that Messrs Sack Goldblatt Mitchell already have copies of Canada's Statement of Defence and the jurisdictional notice filed with it.
