1. By correspondence of 7 November 2014, the Tribunal advised the Parties to confer and propose a timetable for the next steps in the proceeding.
2. By correspondence of 10 December 2014, the Parties communicated their individual proposals for the schedule of the proceeding.
3. By correspondence of 11 December 2014, the Tribunal invited each Party to comment on the other Party's proposal. Each Party provided comments on 18 December 2014.
4. By correspondence of 29 December 2014 and 21 January 2015, the Tribunal invited further comment on the schedule, particularly regarding document production and its impact on the other steps in the proceeding.
5. By correspondence of 19 January 2015 and 29 January 2015, the Parties communicated revised scheduling proposals.

6. The Tribunal, after due consideration of each side's views, has decided to fix the following timetable for the next phase of the proceedings:
 1. Claimants' First Memorial: **5 June 2015**
 2. Respondent's First Memorial: **5 October 2015**
 3. Document production phase
 - 3.1 Requests to produce: **19 October 2015**
 - 3.2 Production or objection: **18 November 2015**
 - 3.3 Reply to objections on contested documents: **2 December 2015**
 - 3.4 Motions to compel with Redfern Schedule: **16 December 2015**
 - 3.5 Production of contested documents completed: **14 days after Tribunal's ruling on contested document requests**
7. Claimants' Reply: **60 days from completion of production for contested documents**
8. Respondent's Rejoinder: **60 days from Claimants' Reply**
9. Evidentiary Hearing: To be determined
